

LIONS DISTRICT 2-S2 CONFLICT OF INTEREST POLICY

The purpose of the conflict of interest policy is to protect this tax-exempt status of Lions District 2-S2 when contemplating entering into a transaction or arrangement that might benefit the private interest of an officer, cabinet member or committee member of the District or might result in a possible excess benefit transaction. This policy is intended to supplement but not replace any applicable state and federal laws governing conflict of interest applicable to nonprofit and charitable organizations.

There shall be no compensation, directly or indirectly, paid to any cabinet member, officer or committee member of District 2-S2, except as provided in the Lions District 2-S2 Constitution and By-Laws.

The Cabinet shall ensure that all transactions or arraignments involving the district are in the best interest of the District.

The District may enter into a transaction or arrangement with a Lion if a better price or product can not be acquired from non-lions.
