

Zone S – 5 Report

District 2-S2 4th Cabinet Meeting (April 27, 2019)

Zone Chair: Neil Lander

Clubs: 11 Clubs in North East District including Cleveland, Crosby, Dayton Noon, Harden, Huffman, Humble Noon, Humble, Kingwood, Liberty and Twin Cities. In addition, Ames Almighty Breakfast Club was just chartered on April 10, 2019 with 20 members (don't know how I missed their charter night.)

Membership: Total Members 240 as of April, up 14, but gained 20 with the newly chartered Ames Almighty Club. So, prior clubs were down 5 after adding 18 new members, but dropped 23. Crosby dropped 11 members mostly for non-payment of dues.

Visitation: Expect to complete another round of club visitations by end of year. Especially want to visit the new chartered club.

Club Reporting Activity: For most part, MMRs are being completed. On Service Activity reporting, achieved 9 of 10 clubs reporting a least one month of activity. There is a good base of 7 clubs reporting routinely. Have sent e-mails to those that I know have had activities, but are not reporting them.

Club Financials: Have significant concern that two clubs have not paid their second half LCI dues. The 90-day grace period is about to expire and they could face suspension if these dues are not paid by May 10. Also, have an additional club that owes second half District dues. All of these, plus one additional club, have not contributed to all of the 100% District Charitable Contributions. Have notified all clubs.

LCI Service Areas - 2018-19

Reviewed the seven clubs that have routinely reported their service activity through April. Of the five areas, only Vision (~90%), Hunger (~9%) and Diabetes (~1%) were reported. There were none reported for Environmental and Pediatric Cancer. Will try to "sell" them on achieving something in these service areas. Overall reported service activity was fairly low in the 1st Quarter of 2019.

Club "Ratings": Still using "best guess" rating for each club visited criteria establish at the beginning of the year. Scale was from "Green-Amber-Red." Some of the benchmarks used included 1. Club Membership (Existing/New/Dropped), 2. Activities, 3. Ability to Raise Funds, 4. Meeting Attendance, 5. President Years in Service, 6. Community Ties, 7. Outside Communications (Facebook/Website), 8. Membership Average Age., 9. Foundation 501c3? and 10. General Feeling of Membership Involvement/Bonding.

Ratings of Clubs Visited: They remain so far as 3 "Green," 3 "Amber" and 3 "Red." Changing the "Red" clubs will take considerable time while treading lightly.

Zone T 1 Report Fourth Cabinet Meeting 2019

News form pour zone is a mixed bag for the year.

The worst news is that we are losing a club. Alief is turning in their charter. The good news in that situation is that our extended Lions family will not lose any Lions. There were 3 members remaining in this club. One is transferring to Cinco Ranch and 2 will be transferring to a club near Navasota where they now live.

The beat news of the year is that a club has been reborn. Houston Founders had become a nonfunctioning club. Under the guidance of Lion Steve Simmons, this club has gone from 1 active member to a current 17 active members. Attached you will find my zone report for the second zone meeting of Zone L. The meeting focused on Membership. All participants were given a 30 day notice of the meeting and it was timed around the March PSC meeting to draw more participation.
