Report of the Global Extension Team - District

DG Bill Simpson has tasked our group to start 8 new clubs during his year as Governor.

I have opened four (4) new club applications with LCI: Crosby (sponsored by Huffman Lions Club); Houston Men in Action (sponsored by Houston Lady Lions); Texas Southern University Campus (sponsored by Houston Lady Lions); and New Caney (sponsored by Humble Noon).

The Global Extension Team - District has been hard at work recruiting potential members for the Crosby Lions Club. Several visits have been made to the Crosby area canvassing the area seeking members. We have been favorably received. Many of those we talked to welcome a Lions Club back into Crosby.
