3rd District 2S2 Cabinet meeting District Leo Report 2024-2025 January 11th, 2025

We have held 2 successful District Leo forums. We still had 6 clubs represented.

We are still working with Lion Nancy Smith, the state Leo coordinator. She has been very helpful and has attended both forums.

The next state Leo meeting is February 8th in Kerrville at the YO Hotel at 9 a.m. This meeting is held at the same time as the State Governors council.

We are hoping to hold our 3rd District Leo forum on February 17th. We are still looking for a club to sponsor that forum.

This year we have received a Leo Grant. The grant is for \$1500 and we have to contribute \$500 for a total of \$2000. We have contacted the Texas Lions Camp in Kerrville, and they asked us to supply craft supplies to make friendship bracelets for the campers. We will be sorting and comprising 1500 craft bags at the Mid-Winter Conference on January 25, 2025. This will be the first part of the project. We will carry out the 2nd part of the project at the camp in June and help campers actually make the bracelets. Lion Stephen King is making an exception for us and allowing us to attend an actual day at the camp.

We are now working with 2 Lions clubs to form 2 Leo clubs this year. Both of these clubs will be specialty Leo clubs in our district. The Lions clubs are working to do a member drive in their area and both will be community clubs.

I am amazed at the number of Lions clubs who have not even discussed sponsoring a Leo club. Especially a few of the larger ones. We hope to change that this year and at least put the discussion on the floor.

Most of our clubs are getting more active. We still have several clubs that are not reporting and have very little or no response from the advisors. We are still working to correct this situation. There are clubs that are inactive but still listed on LCI. We are working with Lion Nancy Smith tot get that corrected as well.

The attached list is a short summary of the clubs. I hope to be able to work with zone chairs and club presidents to get more clubs back into the reporting part of the club responsibility.
