As we wrap up the first quarter, we are proud to announce a very successful first quarter, thanks to the dedication and hard work of all MD-2 districts and lions. At the beginning of the year we all accepted the Mission 1.5 challenge and also to serve over billion people worldwide. Towards those goals we have made significant pro-

gress towards achieving them. MD-2 has recruited about 1150 new members in the first three months for a net gain in membership +331. We have exceeded our goal (see chart). We can do much more than we realize. This is a result of combined effort by MD-2 Lions, especially our DG's, GMT's, GET, GMA, Zone Chairs and club presidents. Communication is the key to success.



Service: This robust membership growth of Lions and new members can easily find meaningful volunteer roles for which they have passion. District wide service projects have increased providing an opportunity for smaller clubs to participate. In the first quarter Lions of MD-2 have served over 674,000 people logging in over 104,000 volunteer hours conducting over 4,200 service projects, making an impact in our communities. Over 38% clubs reporting service activities.

Leadership Training: Emphasis has been on training. State wide zone chair training was organized as they are an important link between the district and clubs. Over 40% of the zone chairs have been trained. Club officers training has been conducted by the districts including new member orientation.

As we look ahead to the rest of the year, we are excited to continue our working the community and those in need. Exciting initiatives for membership growth and charter new clubs to meet the Mission 1.5 goal. .



MD-2 LIONS SERVING OUR COMMUNITIES



In just three months MD-2 Lions have served over 675,000 people in Texas communities. 37% of the clubs have reported their service activities.

TRAINING AND DEVELOPMENT: Over 12% of club officers and 38% of Zone Chairs have attended training sessions.

LCIF CONTRIBUTIONS: MD-2 has received over \$95,000 in donations.

"BUILD BEDS FOR KIDS" A DISTRICT 2-X1 PROJECT

Another WOW Day in service occurred on September 9, 2023, the second "Build Day" for our District. (Our first "Build Day" was on February 8, 2023, when we built and delivered 175 beds to our Texas Lions Camp with our partners SHP and LCIF for an in-kind contribution of \$46,551).

At our more recent "Build Day," we built another 175 beds for children in the Dallas/Ft Worth Area that have no beds to sleep in. These beds will be delivered by our partner Sleep in Heavenly Peace and this time will include participation geographically by Lions Clubs in the delivery area in the delivery of the beds with SHP. Lions get to witness and feel the joy of delivering a bed to a child with no bed. This September 9 was our second "Build Day." We had



272 total volunteers. We raised a total of \$93.435 to build the beds at the two events, including a matching grant from LCIF of \$21,750 and most of it was raised in about 3 months last year. "objectives with this project was to offer to our Lions a project they could do service for others – together. "We Serve Better Together." And it was a resounding success in each "Build." Thank you, Lions!! Way to go! See you on March 16, 2024.
